Our sessions enhance the development of observation skills and the repetition of songs and rhymes enables the children to contribute confidently through words and movement.

Tick Tock During Covid-19 Pandemic

We're so pleased that we can get back to Tick Tock sessions this year. However, there are a few changes we have had to make in order to comply with various government guidelines so that our sessions run smoothly and safely for all. PLEASE READ FULLY.

Session capacity.

Unfortunately, we have to reduce the numbers of families in each session to comply with social distancing and our venues' regulations. Therefore we have a **maximum of 10 families in our sessions at St Stephen's and 15 at St Mary's and maximum 20 at The Arc Centre.** This is under the agreement that a family will be **1 child and 1 adult per booking.** We apologise if this causes any inconvenience. Any siblings under 6 months will be able to be brought along to the session free of charge and are to be kept with the adult for the duration.

Session length

The sessions themselves will be reduced to **30 minutes** in order to fit more sessions in our allotted time at our venues so that more people can enjoy Tick Tock. The new price reflects this reduction in time.

Booking a session

In order to make sure that no one is turned away from a session on the day, all Tick Tock sessions will need to be booked online as we are having to have reduced numbers. To book a session please visit kiddiplan.com and search Tick Tock Music to see all the available sessions.

Price

Due to the reduction in time of our sessions, the price is now **£7 per child.** I can offer a sibling rate which will be an extra £4 but due to the way our booking system works, you will need to **book two spaces** (so as not to exceed capacity) then email or text me to let me know and I shall refund you the £3 difference. I'm sorry this is a little complicated and I shall look into making this more streamlined.

Arriving and leaving the session

To try keep a clean and healthy space, we will open the front doors to the venue **10 minutes before** the session is due to start to allow time to sign in and to make your way into the Tick Tock Space. There will be hand sanitiser on arrival which we ask you to use. There are spaces for buggies at all venues. I kindly ask that as soon as you are ready, you enter into the session and find a space. These spaces will be set out to conform with social distancing where possible.

When the class is over, please make your way out of the session as we will then proceed to do necessary sanitising and can only let the next session in once everyone has left from the one prior. Again, hand sanitiser will be available on the way out. Depending on the weather - windows will be opened in the session to allow air flow.

Prop Bags

We pride ourselves on being very interactive at Tick Tock and allowing children to participate in various parts of the class. We will carry on this part of Tick Tock in a safe manner during Covid. In order to do this, each space will be allocated their own prop bag. Inside the prop bag will be any props and instruments needed for the session, as well as the coveted Tick Tock Biscuit (which are individually wrapped). **Please don't take anything out of the prop bag until prompted during the session so that the focus can be kept throughout.** Once the props have been used, please place them back into the bag so that they can be sanitised for the next session.

Face Coverings

We advise adults to wear a face covering when entering Tick Tock but once at your space in the session, you are free to take it off. Of course, you are more than welcome to wear one throughout should you wish. Children do not need to wear face coverings.

The session leader and assistant will wear visors to welcome you into the building and registration but once we are in the performance space, we will be at a safe distance and the sessions are planned to allow proper distancing when singing and so we will not wear a visor during the session as we feel it will hinder the class.

Cancellation

If you have booked a spot at a Tick Tock session online and then are unable to attend, you must let Liz know via email or phone (details below) at **least 24 hours before the session is scheduled** so that the spot can be re-opened for others to book. You will then get a full refund. Unfortunately, any later than 24 hours, you may incur the full charge as the spot won't be able to be resold.
